



## **Shortened Biography - September 2011**

19-year-old Georgia Germein is an Australian, Adelaide based award winning acoustic/pop/roots singer-songwriter who is already achieving an extensive amount for someone so young in their musical career.

Performing either solo (guitar, piano, vocals), or having her songs brought to new heights with her beautiful sisters Ella Germein (bass/synth, backing vocals) and Clara Germein (drums, backing vocals), her list of live appearances in 2010/2011 is extensive. Touring **NATIONALLY** and **INTERNATIONALLY**, the 'Georgia Germein Sisters' were recently announced as one of the bands performing at the Kangaroo Island Surf Music Festival in November, alongside huge name acts including Eskimo Joe, the Beautiful Girls, Hungry Kids of Hungary, and Ash Grunwald.

Only forming the band just over a year ago, other festivals include Fringe Festival, Fuse Festival, Alice Desert Festival, Sea and Vines Festival, Clare Valley Gourmet Festival, Natuzzi Food, Wine and Music Festival, and Fleurieu Folk Festival. The girls have also supported Music Legends Renee Geyer, Brian Cadd, Russel Morris, Ross Wilson, Joe Camilleri and the Black Sorrows.

Their unique style blends the exuberance of pop with an acoustic earthy texture, topping it off with the ringing purity and precision of her vocal delivery. Drawing on her experiences of growing up in the bush in the Adelaide Hills, her love of the ocean and travelling, combined with her commitment to the Environment, Indigenous Reconciliation, her work in the Kalahari, South Africa and Nepal as World Vision's 2010 Youth Ambassador, Georgia is a promise of extraordinary things coming your way.

Her passion for the environment is also evident, being a youth advocate for the Nature Foundation South Australia, a member of Fauna Rescue, and also a carer of orphaned kangaroo joeys. Part of a beach loving family, Georgia and her sisters are also very keen surfers.
